



HEINZ MEMORIAL CHAPEL on the University of Pittsburgh campus, a fine example of French Gothic architecture, is ecumenical in spirit. Carved of Indiana limestone, its delicate traceries recall *La Petite Sainte Chapelle* in Paris. The 23 stained glass windows (four of which are among the tallest in the world — 73 feet) depict themes of Christianity utilizing religious and historical figures.
